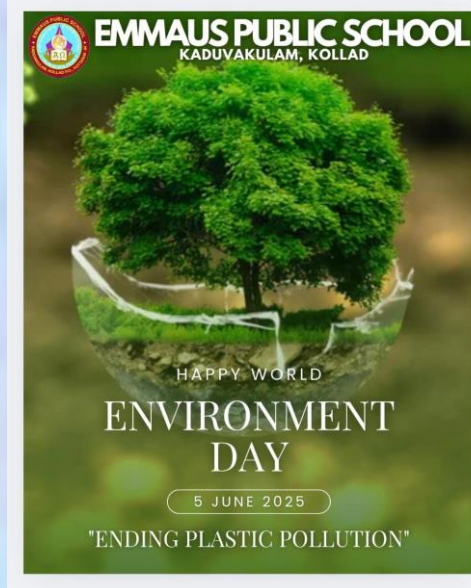

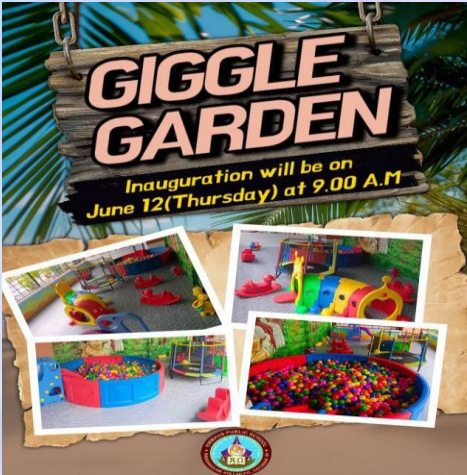
ENVIRONMENT DAY

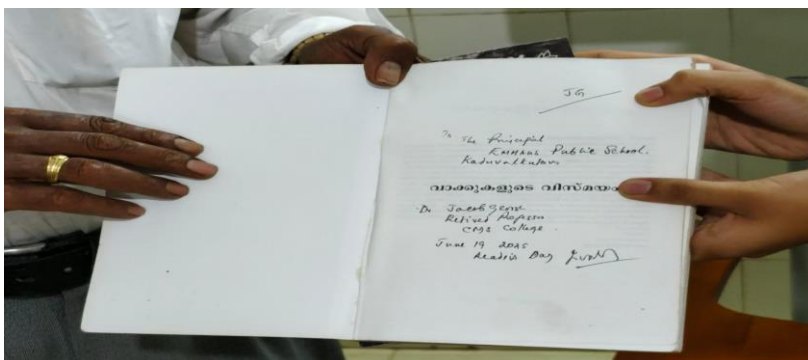
Reading Day
